I found the beautiful, colorful balloons sailing off against the backdrop of a blue summer sky to be very symbolic of artistic ideas



Preparing for Top Dollar Sale

First impressions are everything. Just as with people, the same premise holds true with homes. Your home's curb appeal is the 1st impression your home will give to potential buyers. Therefore, it is important that your home looks cared for, starting with the exterior. Maximum curb appeal starts with the lawn, which should be manicured and as green as possible. Landscaping should be well trimmed and new mulch added to the flower beds which will denote a fresh look. 



5 MUST-HAVES FOR SUMMER FUN

Be sure to check out these important tips for sun safety while having fun down the shore or at the pool this summer!

1. Sunscreen

Sunscreen is an essential component of sun safety. The American Academy of Dermatology recommends using a sunscreen that is at least SPF 30 or higher and has broad spectrum UVA/UVB coverage. Most adults require at least 1 oz. of sunscreen, which is about the size of a shot glass, to cover sun-exposed areas of the body. Make sure to apply 20 minutes before going outside and reapply every 2 hours or after swimming. Don't forget your ears and tops of your feet!

For kids, I like to use a mineralbased chemical-free sunscreen. which has zinc oxide as the active ingredient. My favorite brands include Blue Lizard Baby, Badger Baby, The Honest Company, and Babyganics. Chemical-free sunscreens require more frequent reapplication, so be sure to reapply every 45 minutes to an hour.

I personally use Jan Marini Physical Protectant Broad Spectrum SPF 45 sunscreen every day. Not only does it provide mineral-based broad spectrum coverage, it's a tinted sunscreen so you don't get that chalky white veil. It's also great for those light make-up days and you can just throw it on and go. We carry this in the office, so stop by to pick one up.

2. Wide-Brimmed Hat

Look for a wide-brimmed hat with at least a 3" to 4" brim to adequately shade face, ears, and chest.

Baseball caps and visors do not offer enough coverage and also do not protect the ears. A flap hat may be a good option for those looking for additional posterior neck protection.

3. Swim Shirts and Swim Tights

Swim shirts, also known as rash guards, are a great option for kids so you don't have to chase them down to reapply sunscreen. Make sure they are made from sun protective material that is UPF 50 or higher. I put my kids in swim tights as well, but they can be hard to find. I am a big fan of swim tights and sun protective clothing from Coolibar. (www.coolibar.com)

4. Sun Shelter

Staying out of the sun and seeking shelter during peak sun intensity hours between 11am-3pm is also very important. A pop-up beach cabana is perfect for those long days out at the beach. There are several options online or at your local sporting goods store, and many are convenient to carry and pack down easily.

5. Sunglasses

Just as sunscreen is important for the skin, sunglasses act as sunscreen for the eyes. Long-term sun exposure can accelerate the development of cataracts and exposure to strong sun can even burn the cornea. Look for sunglasses that have the UV 100% sticker for adequate protection, and they don't have to be expensive!

PARALYZED BROTHER OF FAMED SHARK TANK STAR WALKS AGAIN AFTER LIFE-ALTERING SPINE SURGERY

John Corcoran, Barbara Corcoran's brother, became paralyzed after a horrific motorcycle accident last fall and is now getting back to life as he always knew it.

It was Labor Day weekend...a beautiful Saturday afternoon. John Corcoran, owner of Statewide Roofing and Siding in Edgewater, NJ and brother of Shark Tank millionaire, Barbara Corcoran, headed out to do what he loves most – take a ride on his motorcycle.

An experienced rider, John had driven through Morris County hundreds of times...but this time was different. He was on a side road when he came up to a turn too fast. His bike hit a curve and jumped across the road. John was thrown across the road where he landed atop giant concrete blocks. It wasn't until seven hours later that his family located him unconscious in the hospital because his friend – a member of the Edgewater Police Department – pinged his phone.

"John was rushed to Morristown Medical Center," Barbara explains. "He had suffered five crushed vertebrae, 18 broken ribs and lungs that were filled with blood. Worst of all, when he arrived at the hospital, he was paralyzed, having lost all function in his legs and bladder control."

As luck would have it, Dr. Yaron Moshel, a neurosurgeon at Atlantic NeuroSurgical Specialists (ANS), was on call in the trauma center that night. While most physicians would have considered the damage to John's spinal cord rireversible and would not have immediately performed surgery to remove crushed vertebral fragments off of his spinal cord, Dr. Moshel set on a mission to have John walking again.

"Although no one would have expected this amazing outcome, I thought we should give John the benefit of the doubt," Dr. Moshel notes. "We rushed him into surgery to reconstruct his spine and relieve pressure from his spinal cord. It was a risky decision considering his other systemic injuries, but we had the full support of a great trauma team and were able to offer him the surgery within hours of arriving to the hospital instead of days later. When it comes to spinal cord injury, early protection

of the spinal cord and not wasting precious time is critical."

John received specialized care directed by the trauma and neurosurgery teams in the ICU for one month and came out of a month-long sedation moving all of his limbs. After a seven-week hospital stay and a two-week stay in a rehabilitation center, John returned home and began resuming his normal activities.

After seven weeks in the hospital and two in a rehabilitation center, John returned home and began resuming his normal activities – including enjoying time with his grand-daughter, Lilah.



"I'm driving again – although I have not yet gotten back on my motorcycle...it's in the repair shop," John quipped. "I do plan to get back on it...I plan to ski again and do everything else I enjoy. All thanks to the fabulous team of doctors who spent hours, days and almost two months focusing on me. Without them, I wouldn't be here today."

Dr. Moshel added, "I was truly thankful and somewhat surprised that John emerged from his long recovery walking around as if nothing had happened! Traumatic spine injuries can be devastating and to have such a positive outcome in such an upbeat patient keeps us aware of why prompt and high-level care is so important"

"Our whole family feels our brother's recovery is nothing short of a miracle!" Barbara concludes. "We all waited anxiously knowing full well that his chances of walking again were next to zero if not for the quick thinking of Dr. Moshel and the expert care he received. It is truly amazing to see John today.

"We just returned from a short vacation to Utah where, believe it or not, he would have skied had Dr. Moshel not asked him not to," she continues. "John has nine siblings who adore him, and our mom always said John would be a big success because he is such a hard worker. It may have been the habit of working hard that helped put him on the road to recovery. He is an inspiration to us all."

It is summertime and the living is easy. At least that is what the song says. Many people are surprised to learn that couples often begin couples therapy in the summer. There are a lot of reasons for this.

Summertime is a time of change and transition. Children get out of school and move to summer schedules. Decisions need to be made about vacations and time with the extended family. For some, there is much more togetherness. Sometimes couples find that the intimacy that they hope for is lacking. Sometimes the implicit "marital contract," the set of expectations that each person brings to the marriage about life, turns out to be at odds with their partner's. Vacation plans, parenting styles, time management and extended family loyalties can all become grist for the summertime mill.

Summer is also a time of moving on. Families sometimes move, new people move in next door or old friends move away, children go off to camp or to college, and there are endings and new beginnings. Couples may handle these transitions in different ways. They may have expectations about how their partner can help them through a difficult time. But these expectations are not always clear. How couples understand their own desires and those of their partner, is one of the central issues often addressed in couples counseling. Despite knowing someone well, or perhaps because of it, couples sometimes "fill in the blanks." They jump to conclusions about what the other person is saying. Sometimes this is because of well-worn ground within the marriage, where some arguments become almost ritualized in the back and forth between the partners. Fine-tuning problem solving skills can be a helpful outcome from the therapy process.

Couples are drawn towards the familiar. There is an innate tendency to attempt to create a family environment much like the one in which we grew up. There is a certain "right" way of doing things, which often comes down to doing a thing the way our parents did it. But different families do things in different ways. It's said that marriage is a joining of two cultures. Sometimes, these cultures clash. Sometimes this pattern takes place without us even realizing it. At some point in a marriage, the question often comes up, "who is this person?" Therapy helps couples to understand these feelings and identify healthy patterns as the partnership evolves over time.

One goal for therapy may be improving effective communication styles. Sometimes an impartial outsider can help untangle the knots in a relationship which are too overwhelming for the couple themselves. Sometimes, partners need help discussing their assumptions, hopes, and dreams about their marriage and their family. Couples can also learn to fight productively, to stay on topic, and to compromise without resentment.

Relationships do not need to be in distress to benefit from couples therapy. In fact, many people choose to pursue sessions to strengthen an already healthy foundation. 

RGANIZE 5 PRODUCTIVITY HABITS

HIGHLY SUCCESSFUL PEOPLE **DEMONSTRATE**

I have heard it said, (actually it was from Brendon Burchard, one of the top performance coaches in the world) that there are two types of people in this world – "People who say 'I don't know how' and so therefore they stop" and "People who say 'I don't know how' and they go and find out how."

We could perceive that one type is successful while the other is unsuccessful if we were going to view this from a standpoint of productivity. Speaking of productivity I have placed ductivity. Speaking of productivity, I have also heard that highly successful people have a common trait. They are consistent in producing. But beyond that, there are (according to Brendon Burchard) five habits that people demonstrate who are truly productive...let's take a look.

Habit #1: Raise Your Ambitions

"You are only productive to the degree of motivation stirred by your ambitions.

- Brendon Burchard

So what does this quote mean? It asks; What are you fired up about? What are your dreams? If you can't answer this, then perhaps it's time to ask the bigger question... What is your purpose in this life? You can then work your way up from there. We all need to feel connected to something that breeds life in us. Can you remember when you were connected in the past to a dream and how excited you were? I can tell you this, if you are feeling unproductive, it's probably due to unclear ambitions. So go ahead – go for it! Remember this...raising your ambition doesn't have to be about having more money, fancy cars, etc. It can be about service, such as being a better dad or a better boss. Even monks strive to deepen their meditation to their source...think about it!

Habit #2: Own Your Morning

Now, let's be truthful here. If your morning is running on chaos, your day will be trapped in reaction mode – yes? Of course it will be. I learned a few statistics from Brendon on this matter. I learned that we can gain 30% of our productivity if we choose not to check our email in the first 60 minutes of waking up. It seems that 85% of us grab our phone upon rising, perhaps before we even give our significant other a morning kiss. Amazing isn't it? I mean seriously, be honest...do you do this? If you do, well guess what - you're the ultimate reactionary!

Let's take back control of our morning by simply putting some things into place that can help immediately:

- Activate your body in the morning you're more resilient if you workout - try yoga/breathing/basic movements stretch 15/20 minutes.
- Eat a healthy breakfast don't skip this important meal. Work on this - trust me, it will serve you well.
- Set your intention and an exact work

schedule. For example, let's say you are writing a book – well, set a time for how long you will write for and stick to it remember, productivity needs a deadline.

Habit #3: Work the Needle Movers

In other words, identify the things that need the most attention and work on them. Did you know that 80% of what we work on doesn't matter and it's only the 20% that actually does? Perhaps this tells us a little story on what we are focusing on. Yes, you heard me, we need to focus on what is important otherwise it will become a distraction if you choose those tasks outside of it.

I found this little tip to be extremely helpful:

Prioritize impact, not ease. This simply means to attack the stuff that will have the most impact towards tomorrow, the next day, and your vision.

Habit #4: Demonstrate, Then Delegate

Well this has always been a big one for me. I am a firm believer that before we can turn our work over to another - we first must master it. Meaning, we need to know the ins and outs of all of our work and feel confident that we understand all of it before we delegate. How else can we expect another to do the type of job we expect of them? If we don't, we just set ourselves up for failure.

Habit # 5: Use Performance Enhancers

I know, what you must be thinking...caffeine...right? No, no, not at all. There are three top performance enhancers that can help us focus and be more productive.

- Sleep It's so important. Did you know that recent studies show that if you sleep 6 hours or less a night, that after the 10th day you are considered legally drunk?
- Meditation It's proven to lower stress and puts the brain in a better state. It also allows the brain to recover better as you transition from one task to another. It's important to note that any time you do anything big you need to recover with hydration, movement, and a mental
- Plan Yes, you heard it right. Listen, it's important to plan your day, otherwise you will just be thinking through your stuff. As Brendon says, "If you plan your day, you'll be a weapon in your day" - awesome, right?



Changing Lives Through Literacy Bridgewater Wegmans Awarded as a Community Champion

Without functional literacy skills many adults in our community struggle: they cannot read a street sign, menu, or email; writing a note to a child's teacher or a check to pay a bill is overwhelming; speaking to a co-worker is daunting and calling 9-1-1 may be impossible. Literacy Volunteers of Somerset County (LVSC) can help.

Since 1981, LVSC has been training volunteers to become literacy tutors who work with adult students on a one-to-one basis. Students come to LVSC because they want to change their lives and they know that improving their literacy skills is the first step. Students are matched with a tutor and the pair meets weekly, usually at the local library. Together tutors and students work toward the student's real life goals - getting a better job, reading to a child, or becoming a US citizen. As students' literacy levels improve, they become more productive

employees, parents who are engaged in their child's education, and active members of the community.

When LVSC was formed 35 years ago by a retired school teacher named Alma C. Liotta, the organization's mission was to help American-born adults learn to read. At inception, LVSC did not have paid staff and served a small number of students. The world has changed significantly since that time, but much about LVSC has remained the same. Today, LVSC has a small staff of two Bridgewater women who work with 175 volunteers and manage four programs serving 350 students each year. In addition to the cornerstone Tutor Training program, LVSC's services have expanded to include English Conversation Groups, US Citizenship Preparation Classes, and English as a Second Language classes offered in partnership with Spotlight Learning. Although the size of its program has grown, LVSC remains a community-focused, nonprofit organization.

To support a growing garden of literacy programs, and to celebrate 35 years of service, LVSC held a Garden of Literacy Brunch and Silent Auction in April. During this festive event, Martha Davis, LVSC Board President, presented LVSC's Community Champion Award to Bridgewater Wegmans Community Giving Team Leader, Sue Monroe. Ms. Davis remarked, "Wegmans is not just a supermarket. Wegmans is also about giving back and making a difference in every community it serves. Wegmans has been a wonderful supporter and has taken abundant care of our event needs. We are always so grateful to receive a generous response that they will help us once again."

Students are grateful for the free assistance provided by their tutors and have shared

sentiments such as, "my life is better now," "my tutor is the breath of life," and "I am not afraid of talking with people in English anymore." Tutors find the experience to be equally transformative. One tutor recently wrote, "After each class my students thank me profusely... inside I am thanking them... I have been privileged to have a glimpse into their lives and struggles, and to assist along the way. The richness of the experience will carry with me always.'



Storm King Art Center

If you are looking to spend some time communing with nature amid incredible outdoor sculptures, consider a visit to the Storm King Art Center. Located in the Hudson Valley just off the Thruway north of Woodbury Commons, Storm King has more than 100 sculptures arrayed over 500 acres of fields, grasses, hills and woods. It is a spectacular setting through which you can walk, bike (they provide rentals) or ride a tram.

The nonprofit Storm King Art Center was founded and opened to the public in 1960. It was originally envisioned as a museum devoted to the Hudson River School, but within a few years, its founders had become committed to modern sculpture. Early purchases were placed directly outside of the main Museum Building as part

of a formal garden scheme. However, after a particularly large acquisition of thirteen works in the mid 60's, Storm King began to place sculpture directly in the landscape. Since then, every work has been situated on the site with careful consideration given to both its immediate surroundings and distant views.

It is hard not to be awestruck by Storm King's dramatic landscape which includes farmed fields, natural woodlands, lawns, native grasses, wetlands, and water. The inherent beauty of the region is constantly on view in the surrounding hills and meadows as you walk the paths viewing art installations both small and large (some are huge) in a variety of mediums. The collection includes works by some of the world's top artists such as Louise Bourgeois, Alexander Calder, Sol Lewitt, Roy Lichtenstein, Maya Lin, Henry Moore, Louise Nevelson, Barnett Newman, Isamu Noguchi and Richard Serra to name a few.

Besides its permanent collection, each year Storm King features a variety of special exhibitions. These could be large-scale sculptures located on the grounds in some appropriate setting, or they could be smaller works shown in the Museum Building. More than fifty years after its founding, Storm King continues to grow and evolve and is considered to be one of the world's leading sculpture parks.

Storm King Art Center is open daily Wednesday to Sunday from April through November and on select holiday Mondays – Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Columbus Day. Any day is a good one to visit Storm King as each season offers its own special backdrop for these amazing artworks.

WHERE TO EAT

Storm King Art Center has a wonderful full service café in an outdoor pavilion, perfect for a snack or a light meal

Storm King Cafe, Adjacent to

North Parking Area – fresh salads, sandwiches, snacks, scones, excellent chili and daily soups, seasonal specials, organic and locally grown ingredients, kid friendly too.

Some visitors choose to pack a picnic lunch and find a beautiful spot on the grounds to enjoy it; others head to one of the surrounding towns for lunch or dinner. The Hudson Valley has become an extremely popular tourist destination with lots to see and do. The local towns (e.g., Beacon, Croton-on Hudson, Newburgh, Cornwall) are filled with interesting shops and restaurants of every type, many featuring locallysourced ingredients and craft beers. It is a lovely area to ride around and explore after your visit to Storm King. There are also many charming bed and breakfast options if you want to stay overnight or make a weekend of it. A CONNECTION THAT IS HARD TO MATCH

In the fall of 1967, our family visited my Aunt and Uncle in Greenwich, Connecticut. One day we had lunch at a family restaurant called Lucy's in nearby Port Chester, New York. As we were leaving the restaurant, I picked up a matchbook. I am not sure why I grabbed it as I was in my early teens and didn't smoke. I may have been attracted to the design. One of my family members suggested that I start a matchbook collection. And I did, accumulating over 7,000 matchbooks since then.

I could never have anticipated that my "collection of little fires" would become the nucleus for many connections in orbit around it, spanning nearly fifty years.

Four years after our visit, in 1971, Lucy's was reopened with a new concept, as Gulliver's Restaurant and Lounge. It attracted crowds of young people, particularly Connecticut residents, since the drinking age at the time was lower in New York than Connecticut.

Steve, one of my best friends from college, living in Connecticut after graduation, hung out at Gulliver's every Friday and Saturday night in the mid-70's. I was living in Detroit at that time. On Sunday morning, June 30, 1974, I opened the front door of my apartment to retrieve my copy of the Sunday edition of The Detroit Free Press, which had just been delivered. The front page headline read something to the effect, "24 Die in New York Nightclub Fire."

After reading the opening paragraph of the article, I immediately

called Steve's parents. Turns out that he was not feeling well during the week and decided, for the first time in months, not to go clubbing at Gulliver's that weekend.

Back to 2016. This past February, I started a consulting engagement with a new client. I flew to Portland. Maine, to meet the company's Chief Operating Officer, John. Over lunch, the conversation shifted from business background to personal and professional histories. At one point, John revealed that he grew up near Port Chester.

I said, "Did you ever go to Lucy's restaurant?"

"Never heard of it," he replied.

I continued, "It became a nightclub which burned down and over twenty people died."

I was amazed when he said, "I knew the guy who set the fire, a troubled kid and high school dropout."

After this conversation with my new client, I did some further research. Lucy's restaurant was originally named the Old Post Grill, which burned down in 1962. The restaurant then became Lucy's which had also had a fire in 1968.

From the Old Post Grill to Lucy's to Gulliver's - three restaurants, three fires, 24 dead, my best friend at college not there (fortunately), then learning recently that my client knew the arsonist, and a matchbook collection which started there nearly five decades ago. Is this just a random connection? Let me hear from you.

The Resilience of a Warrior

We all knew the day would come, having heard two words, pancreas and cancer strung together in a lethal combination, creating for all intents and purposes, an assault weapon! Over these past four years, however, our warrior, Larry, continuously fired his own assault weapon against his mortal enemy, teaching all of us who knew and loved him, the true meaning of a word many take for granted...resilience. And although we may have fooled ourselves into believing his victory would be measured in decades, not years, he and his partner at every step on the road he traveled, his loving wife Beth, taught us to move forward, ever forward, always seeking the next treatment, adding a huge dose of hope. There were many times we expected the end, Larry would rebound, and we would receive his message..."I am back to fight another battle!" He had more roads to travel, and cancer was not going to deter that travel. No, he was always looking ahead, whether it was to his next treatment, or the next date with his grandchildren!

Larry was one of the most resilient men I know,"succeeding, even excelling, despite incredibly difficult circumstances," as one might define resilience. But until cancer entered his daily vocabulary, we thought of him as simply a dear friend with an incredible sense of humor; warm, witty, caring, smart, cultured (adoring the opera, an interest in a wide variety of books and movies) socially enjoying a drink and dinner with friends...us...he was part of the fabric of our lives.

Beth and I had learned at a young age how important it is for busy friends to carve out time together, so for probably 30 years, she and I have a weekly appointment to speak with each other every Saturday morning at 8:00. We sometimes joke that if anything major were to happen during the week, it would be fine to call at another time, but we are so devoted to our connection on Saturdays that both her family and mine rarely infringe upon our date with one another. Over the years, because I am always ahead of myself, I began to call at 7:57 a.m., and one time, when I reverted to the 8:00 time, Larry pointed out that I was "late!"

Just a few Saturdays ago, we were joyfully discussing Larry's acceptance at Memorial Sloan Kettering for a medical trial of immunotherapy, a new frontier in the treatment of aggressive cancers. The physicians were as impressed with his drive, determination, fight, spirit, and yes, unbelievable sense of humor as all of us who love him, have been. His doctor told Beth and him that she was so pleased she had two successes already with the protocol, and Larry told her "he gladly volunteered to be her third!" He wanted to win this battle any way possible...after all, he had grandsons to watch grow, new grandchildren to be born, a wife to love and cherish, sons and daughters-in-law to adore, friends and family to write into his book of life. He was willing to be poked and prodded, weakened and rebuilt...whatever it took to live longer, to find the cure for himself and others. But two days ago, in our Saturday conversation, I learned that, in fact, Larry wasn't doing well. He was feeling very poorly, and unless it was a passing virus, hopes were fading he would be well enough to make the trial date the following week. The disappointment was palpable all around, as I notified my family and close friends who kept Larry in their healing thoughts.

From that Saturday morning, the end came quickly, and by early the next day, he was gone. Four years of donning his armor, and jousting with abandon; four years of awakening the victor...four years of resilience and fortitude...his unique determination always driving him, until he could fight no longer.

Tomorrow will be the day of farewell to our formidable warrior, and many will say his life was shortened by his enemy...and it was. But I will always treasure what Larry taught me...that resilience is how we face adversity, and that instead of succumbing, he surmounted the threats we all fear. He did it well, he did it longer than most, he used his humor and determination to keep him moving in the right direction. I believe that none of us knows how resilient we are capable of being until we are challenged. I doubt Larry ever knew what he was capable of being...but during these four years, he showed us how well he was able to do it.



Life Can be Stressful- Let JFS Help

For 36 years JFS has been providing counseling to individuals, couples and families living in our community who are struggling with the stresses of life. Following are examples of the people JFS has helped and continues to help every day.

Gary was a 15 year old high school student when he first came to Jewish Family Service. His father who had a kidney disease had recently passed away. Gary was very close with his father. They spend a lot of time together and especially liking to participate in sports together. When his father died suddenly Gary became both angry and depressed. Although he was a good student he began cutting class. His grades fell dramatically and he became disruptive at home. His mother felt he needed a male role model and reached out to JFS for help over Gary's objections. With encouragement he kept the first appointment and over time developed a very positive relationship with the JFS therapist. Gradually his grades began to improve. Time in the therapeutic sessions was split between discussions about school, relationships and the loss of his father and shared a common interest in baseball and the local teams. As the therapeutic relationship developed Gary showed significant improvement in his grades in both his junior and senior years. Gary is naturally smart and did very well on his SAT'S and was accepted into a prestigious university on scholarship. Now when home on vacations he has sometimes come to the office to update the JFS therapist on his progress. With the help of his therapist and JFS, Gary is back on track and feeling better about himself coming to terms with the loss of his father.

Ronald is an eight year old boy who was referred to the agency by his second grade teacher. The teacher was concerned about Ronald's sudden poor academic performance and his developing anger in his interaction with his classmates. Ronald's parents were equally concerned and participated in a comprehensive agency evaluation of the symptoms Ronald presented as well as an exploration of the overall functioning of the family.

The evaluation revealed that Ronald's older brother, Charles, was recently diagnosed with juvenile diabetes. Charles' medical problems resulted in the parents becoming greatly preoccupied and worried about him to the extent that Ronald's needs for attention and affection were, unintentionally, being neglected. This situation was producing significant depression and anger for Ronald, and was being acted out in school. The evaluation also uncovered Ronald's fear of becoming ill, like his brother.

The therapeutic intervention involved individual sessions with Ronald and separate sessions with his parents. The parents were helped to understand how their concerns for Charles were affecting Ronald. As understanding took place, Ronald's parents were able to focus more on his needs. Individual sessions with Ronald helped him to feel valued and cared about and helped him deal with the fear of becoming ill like Charles. As sessions with Ronald and his parents progressed, Ronald's symptoms slowly abated and his teacher began to report a return to good academic performance and improved interaction with classmates.

In addition to providing Mental Health Services, JFS is committed to serving the needs of the entire community and offers a continuum of programs and services. Licensed clinical social workers provide individual, couple and family counseling as well as geriatric assessments, supportive counseling and case management services for home bound elderly. The Family Mentor Program recruits, trains and

matches volunteers with vulnerable young families or with elderly persons for friendly, supportive, in-home visits; Families with children with special needs are assisted through social groups, parent groups and through the Family Mentor Program. Career Counseling helps individuals in many aspects of their job search. Ohr Tikvah-Light of Hope Jewish Healing Services offers presentations, support groups, and individual spiritual counseling to address the health, wellness and healing needs of the community. All information is confidential. Many programs are at no cost, on a sliding fee scale or payable through third party

REPAIR, RENEW, RESTORE RIPPED-JEAN

I know it's been the style for a while but every time I see the stylish ripped jeans I think of my grandmother's reaction to spending good money on intentionally torn clothing and have to smile. So what happens once you put your foot through that stylish gash? Keep on wearing them, I suppose, until they become too unseemly even for the wearer. But you love them; they are your favorite jeans.

During my childhood, once your pants tore, mom would use an iron-on patch of red, blue or green, usually to cover holes in the knees. The pants were then play clothes you wore after school. That would not fly now. So recently, my daughter brought me her favorite shorts that were more holes than stable fabric. She was ready to make the sacrifice and throw them away. I've patched many a pair of jeans. Usually I have to beg to reduce the fashionable tears and bring the jeans back to presentable status. So with these shorts ready for the ragbag, I was granted the opportunity to make them wearable once again. So here are the steps for renewing those favorites.



First, locate old denim. Sacrifice an old pair of jeans. [I have saved my husband's old denim jeans for years (a future project and article, I'm sure). They are the source of old denim needed for patching.] Areas of high stress need to be reinforced with extra fabric, not just quickly stitched to close a tear.

Second, measure and cut a patch at least a half-inch on all sides larger than the tear/gap. Pin the patch to the inside of the garment.

Third, set your machine with a heavy duty denim needle and denim blue thread.

Then, sew around the tear first, then continue to stitch around and through to secure.

- Use either a straight stitch or small zigzag.
- Have fun and stitch around some patches twice or make designs.
- Try using fancy stitches like a flower chain or leaves.
- Add other textures... I made a crochet patch of hairpin lace using denim cotton yarn (Lily's Cotton Sugar'n Cream Denim in indigo)
- Add other color thread. Try other shades of blue, white or your favorite colors.
- Add other color patches. Use other favorite fabric patches.



Final step, trim all the patches close to stitching on the inside. This will make the patch more comfortable on the inside and reduce bulk.

I'm happy to say, the results were approved and the shorts are once again being worn in public without fear. My fear.





CKI is also a caring and supportive spiritual family. 


