





**DEVELOPING SELF ESTEEM IN CHILDREN**

Recently, I was watching a rising comedian doing his standup routine. At one point in his performance he told a joke that did not elicit any laughter from the audience. He smoothly commented on the fact that it did not go over very well, making fun of himself. The audience then laughed and clapped. The comedian responded by saying, "Please don't clap for my failures, which elicited even more laughter.

I thought about this statement. Please Don't Clap For My Failures. I related it to the well known high school commencement speech "You're Not Special" delivered back in 2012. The message delivered by that speech was not to make the graduating class feel badly about themselves, but rather to gently dismantle their false sense of success and perhaps even entitlement due to their parents' misguided treatment of their "specialness." In our attempt to cultivate positive self esteem in our children, we sometimes go overboard in identifying their accomplishments, and either gloss over or try to convert their failures into a positive.

Self esteem is both fundamental and foundational for a happy, healthy child and adult. It is important to understand how your view of yourself develops. Self esteem is largely built on successful and unsuccessful experiences underscored by the type of feedback your child receives regarding those experiences. Social Learning Theory applies here in that if you are positively recognized for an accomplishment it makes you feel good about yourself. If your actions or performance receives a negative reaction, it makes you feel badly about yourself. It is the accumulation of thousands of these paradigms that eventually shape our self esteem. Of course, it is far more complicated than that with many other factors coming into play. But for the purpose of this article, let's

keep it simple.

In my close to 40 years working with patients I have come to one core conclusion about self esteem. I believe that a healthy self esteem consists of a balanced combination of self recognition of both your strengths as well as an emotional and intellectual acceptance of your weaknesses. Simply providing your child with accolades about their efforts and accomplishments alone will not create a healthy self esteem. They also need to learn to accept their failures both emotionally and intellectually so that they can turn them into learning experiences. Acceptance of weaknesses as part of a healthy self esteem is essential because it prevents defensiveness when they make mistakes, allows them to accept responsibility for their errors, and most importantly, helps them have a realistic schema, or portrayal of themselves. So, as parents, it is important to appropriately recognize your child's positive traits, and equally important to realistically point out their limitations to help them accept them, work around them, and feel that it is okay to even have them.

Don't clap for their failures. Help them understand them, learn from them, and create a realistic view of themselves. The result will be a self assuredness with no pretense and an inner acceptance of who they are and who they aren't. Realistic acceptance of yourself not only leads to being happy with yourself, it minimizes your child's need to succumb to peer pressure in an effort to gain acceptance. Clap for their successes. Recognize and allow them to own their failures.





Tooth sensitivity is one of the most common complaints of dental patients. At least 40 million people in the United States suffer at some time from tooth sensitivity.

A spoonful of ice cream or a sip of hot coffee can be extremely painful for someone suffering from sensitivity. In extreme cases, even brushing or flossing can be unpleasant.

In healthy teeth, a layer of enamel protects the crowns of your teeth – the part above the gum line while your gums protect the tooth root. Underneath your tooth enamel and gum tissue is dentin. When dentin loses its protective covering of enamel or gums, tubules inside the dentin allow heat, cold or acidic foods to reach the nerves inside the tooth. The result can be hypersensitivity.

Causes of Sensitivity include:

- Tooth decay (cavities)
- Fractured teeth
- Worn fillings
- Gum disease
- Worn tooth enamel
- Exposed tooth root

Sensitivity is tough to avoid! Eating highly acidic foods like citrus, soft drinks and even salad dressings can lead to sensitivity. Stress can cause grinding or clenching which wears down enamel. Poor oral hygiene can cause gum disease which can cause root exposure. And even people with good oral hygiene may use abrasive toothpastes or whitening products which can contribute to sensitivity.

Some people can improve their sensitivity by using desensitizing tooth-paste, which contains compounds that help block the transmission of sensation from the tooth surface to the nerve. However, it requires several applications before the sensitivity is reduced. Additionally, you should

avoid hard-bristle tooth brushes which can expose sensitive spots. Many people require additional help to alleviate their symptoms.

When tooth sensitivity lingers for more than 3 to 4 days and reacts to hot or cold temperatures, you should consult your dentist to determine the reason for your discomfort.

### What can be done about tooth sensitivity? Your dentist may suggest one of the following treatments:

- Fluoride is a product your hygienist may use which strengthens tooth enamel and reduces the transmission of sensations. Additionally, using concentrated fluoride can significantly reduce the likelihood for developing cavities for children and adults.
- A crown or bonding may correct a flaw or decay which causes sensitivity.
- Surgical gum grafting will protect the root and reduce sensitivity by adding gum tissue to areas where it receded due to gum disease, stress grinding, or hard brushing.
- If sensitivity is severe and persistent and cannot be treated by other means, your dentist may recommend a root canal therapy to eliminate the problem.

### THE POWER OF PROPER POSTURE

Look Great. Get Strong. Be Healthy.

The power of proper posture helps you to look great, get strong and be healthy. Poor posture is a habit that may have begun during your childhood and perpetuated through adulthood due to lifestyle, inactivity and/or repetitive slouching. Poor posture will affect your health, is less aesthetically appealing, and creates a persona of being unhealthy, less energized and less confident in general.

Inadequate or poor posture insidiously creates spinal problems or at the very least weakens the spine thus predisposing it to problems. Interestingly, many spinal problems develop without any incidence of trauma or sudden injury. Actually this is the majority of cases, and in these cases the primary cause of back pain is due to poor posture and poor body mechanics which creates spinal disc, joint and muscle stress. Poor body mechanics include how we lift things and move our bodies as well as how we posture ourselves in front of computers, driving, sitting in front of the TV and sleeping. Consistently maintaining good posture and body mechanics helps support our spine. Repetitively failing to do so will weaken the spine, slowly wearing on the muscles, ligaments and discs. This is behind why so many claim to have done 'nothing' when their back 'went out'. They didn't have to. It was already weak and primed to do so!

Poor posture creates significant muscle, joint and spinal disc stress that initially and possibly for some time, may only cause tension, tightness or achiness and frequently may not give any symptoms at all! But, constantly holding your body in an improper position while standing, sitting or lying down will gradually affect your health overtime. It creates spinal muscle imbalances (some muscles tighten and some weaken or become inhibited). This compounds the adverse effects of spinal stress and increases the risk of injury. Overtime, the stress on those structures will create more significant problems such as herniated spinal discs, spinal arthritis and pinched

nerves. Having an MRI is valuable when there is strong evidence to believe that structural damage has actually occurred to the disc or other spinal structures. This is typically not the case, especially early on. A thorough consultation and examination by a doctor who specializes in spinal care is paramount.

Poor posture and being overweight also creates an undesirable self-image and can be harmful to your health. Maintaining a healthy weight will eliminate being too heavy around the waist which adds stress and strain to your lower back. A customized exercise program will help manage your weight and develop strong abdominal muscles which are the back's greatest support.

Poor posture also causes other health issues. Standing tall gives your internal organs more room in the abdomen allowing the digestive system to function properly. It also allows your respiratory system to work better by enabling your lungs to take deep breathes. Slumping over restricts your breathing, creating less oxygen and therefore less energy. Being able to take deep breathes is also a relaxation technique that helps you to temper stress.

Stories about eating disorders are often in the news - some enlightening and some sensational. It can be hard to know what to do if you or a loved one is struggling. Years of clinical studies point to one certainty. Eating disorders are about much more than eating. In a culture obsessed with appearance and dieting, how do you recognize when a person's behaviors have become dangerous?

The Diagnostic and Statistical Manual for Mental Disorders – Fifth Edition (DSM-5) now categorizes eating disorders (ED) into three categories: Anorexia Nervosa, Bulimia Nervosa and Binge Eating Disorder. Anorexia Nervosa is characterized by severe restricting of food intake, fear of gaining weight, difficulty maintaining a healthy weight and body image distortion. Weight loss may be so significant that the person becomes medically unstable. Bulimia Nervosa is diagnosed when a person binge eats a large amount of food, and then tries to undo the binge, either with vomiting, abusing laxatives or over-exercising. He/she often feels stressed and guilty about these actions. Binge Eating Disorder, the most recent addition to the DSM-5, involves frequent binges when not physically hungry, without the purging behaviors of bulimia. There is shame, embarrassment and guilt and a sense of loss of control.

All three disorders involve disordered eating, concerns and misperceptions regarding appearance, and sometimes (but not always) severe distress and discomfort. There are medical and psychological factors at play. The consequences of these illnesses can be severe, and at times fatal. Other mental health issues can co-exist with these problems, most frequently depression, anxiety and substance abuse.

One of the most perplexing questions is why? Why do some people develop these issues and others do not? There are many factors that may contribute. There are biological contributions such as genetics and temperament. There are social and cultural issues such as societal pressures to be thin and unrealistic messages about appearance sent through ads, television and film. Also, social media may distort our expectations about ourselves and our lives. Psychological factors often include low self-esteem, difficulty with coping, perfectionism and lack of healthy boundaries.

The good news is that treatment is available to help those in trouble move on to healthier behaviors and a more balanced life. Most treatment is multidimensional, involving psychotherapy, nutritional education and medical monitoring. Medications can also be helpful to address anxiety and depression issues when present. The first step is to identify the problem. It is an act of great courage to reach out and seek assistance. Many people suffer in silence for years before they ask for help. The more you can educate yourself about these questions and answers, the better able you are to take action for yourself or your loved one.

### "WHAT MORE CAN BE DONE?" - THE CRITICAL QUESTION THAT CAN SAVE A STROKE VICTIM

Newly proven, minimally invasive treatment removes blood clots and has patients returning home as good as new

The normal response from the doctor used to be, "He suffered a stroke. There's nothing more we could do." Especially if the patient sought medical care after the sixhour treatment window.

Today, the response should be much different. So it's critical the patient's loved ones or caregiver ask the all-important question: "What more can be done?"

Not every emergency room physician or neurosurgeon has the training to answer, "There is something that can be done." But, according to Ronald P. Benitez, neurosurgeon and president of Atlantic Neuro-Surgical Specialists, there is.

"Using a stent retriever, we can now go into the brain within eight to 10 hours of the stroke – in some instances – even longer, remove the clot and restore blood flow to the brain," he explains. "This minimally invasive treatment is successful in patients who have suffered ischemic strokes. An ischemic stroke – the most common type – is caused when a brain artery becomes blocked, prohibiting normal blood flow to the brain."

Benitez was a pioneer of this treatment when the first device was introduced in 2004. Despite advancements that have been made since then and proven medical success, it wasn't until just recently that results of studies confirming the effectiveness of stent retrievers were released at the International Stroke Conference 2015 in Nashville.

The results showed treatment with the latest generation stent retrievers – the Trevo by Stryker and the Solitaire FR by Covidien – reduced post-stroke disability and increased the proportion of patients alive and independent at three months. Four studies showed convincing evidence of benefit

"Removing a clot stuck in a blood vessel is somewhat similar to removing a cork stuck in a wine bottle," Benitez details. "We insert the stent into the blood clot and open it to restore the blood flow. The clot attaches to the retriever and comes out when the device is removed.

"This treatment works well in patients with brain tissue that has not been damaged by the lack of blood flow," he continues. "When the brain tissue is alive, but on sleep mode like a computer, we are often able to awaken it."

Dr. Benitez does 80-100 of these procedures a year with amazing results.

"Typically, we see a stroke patient enter the hospital unable to speak and move one side," Benitez concludes. "Many times, after removing the clot, the patient walks out of the hospital and goes home talking. It is truly miraculous."

Despite these advances, seeking medical treatment at the onset of symptoms is still critical, so know the symptoms of stroke:

- SUDDEN numbness or weakness of face, arm or leg especially on one side of the body
- SUDDEN confusion, trouble speaking or understanding
- SUDDEN trouble seeing in one or both eyes
- SUDDEN trouble walking, dizziness, loss of balance or coordination
- SUDDEN severe headache with no known cause

Women's symptoms may be different including:

- Loss of consciousness or fainting
- General weakness
- Difficulty or shortness of breath
- Confusion, unresponsiveness or disorientation
- Sudden behavioral change
- Agitation
- Hallucination
- Nausea or vomiting
- Pain
- Seizures
- Hiccups

Also, know the location of your nearest stroke center that employs stent retrievers. In New Jersey, ANS performs these procedures at Overlook Medical Center in Summit, Jersey Shore Medical Center in Neptune, St. Barnabas Medical Center in Livingston, and Morristown Medical Center in Morristown.

That way, when you ask that all-important question, "What more can be done," you'll get the right answer.







Summer is finally here! I am graciously welcoming these longer and warmer days by spending more time outdoors. Whether I'm working in the garden (or watching other people work in the garden), exercising outside or just spending time with friends and family on the patio, I'm happy to be spending more time outdoors. The first thing I notice when I'm outside are the transcending scents of summer blooming flowers, fresh cut grass, and the lingering aroma of a neighbor's grill teasing my senses. My mouth begins to salivate when I inhale the sweet caramelized aromas of barbeque.

#### ROSÉ

Whenever someone asks me for the perfect summer wine, my immediate response is rosé. Not only is rosé refreshing and best drunk chilled, but it is also one of the most versatile wines that pairs with many cuisines, like grilled fish, pork, or burgers.

Rosés have a wonderful vibrant color that can range from pale salmon to deep pink. Made from red grapes, rosé wines get their festive color from the skins of the grapes being left in contact with the juice for a short period of time. They are less intense than red wine, but have more depth than a light white wine. My recommendation is to drink rosés while they are young and fresh. Rosés come both dry and off-dry (a touch of sweetness),

so the best question to ask your friendly wine specialist when purchasing a rosé is "Is it dry?" They will help you identify a rosé that best fits your taste.

#### **SAUVIGNON BLANC**

Crisp and clean in style, Sauvignon Blanc is a great wine to pair with simply seasoned dishes like shellfish, seafood and grilled vegetables. This easy drinking aromatic white wine generally has wonderful acidity with citrus flavors and grassy notes. It is my go-to white wine when I host a summer party. You can find refreshing Sauvignon Blancs from all over the world: from Sancerre in the Loire Valley of France to Marlborough, New Zealand. Personally, being a "Napaphile," I love Sauvignon Blanc from California. Napa Valley is producing more and more Sauvignon Blancs that rival the best in the world.

#### **ZINFANDEL**

A summer wine recommendation list is not complete without the perfect red wine. For a wine that stands up to grilled meats lathered with barbeque sauces or homemade marinades, I personally enjoy Zinfandel. Its full-bodied spicy fruit flavors and rich boldness is a perfect pairing for grilled chicken, beef or lamb. Look for wonderful Zinfandels from the Russian River Valley or Paso Robles in California.

As someone who loves discovering wine, it gives me great pleasure to share discoveries with friends and family. Wine is best enjoyed when shared amongst loved ones. I hope these summer wine recommendations will enhance your (or your host's) party. And like the transcending scents of summer, it is the summer memories that we create with friends and family that transcend time. Cheers to you, and have a fun and festive summer!

### **Gotham West** Market

Food halls have been a staple of the New York City restaurant scene for many years, and their number and popularity continue to grow as does the quality of the vendors and the variety of what is offered. They range from old time favorites like the one at Grand Central Terminal to highly stylized concepts like Eataly to ones featuring small-scale artisanal vendors of which the Gotham West Market is an excellent and fairly new example.

Located on the far west side of Midtown on the outer edge of the area known as Hell's Kitchen, Gotham West brings together a little Brooklyn, some Manhattan, a little Spain, a bit of Tokyo and a touch of Mexico to a block where good eats have been few and far between. But the address is exactly why this new eating spot came to exist - it was built to attract tenants to the luxury rental apartments located atop the market...if you feed them, they will come.

Gotham West spans the entire block of 11th Avenue between 44th and 45th Streets. There are nine vendors preparing great food in a wonderful setting: floor to ceiling windows, industrial chic décor, seating choices from beautiful stainless steel bars to communal picnic tables, cool lighting, indoor and outdoor options, perfect for singles, couples and small or large groups.

Here you can experience the wonders of Ivan Ramen, famous in Tokyo and a New York favorite, without waiting in line for a seat. Yes, the soup and rice bowls are legendary, but the garden salad (Asian style with crispy onions on top) is delicious too. The fried green tomato BLT at Genuine Roadside is amazing and rivals the fried chicken sandwich for which they are famous. The tapas at El Colmado are first rate – the stuffed dates wrapped in bacon are a personal favorite, and their dollar oyster happy hour brings joy to bivalve lovers. Choosing an ice cream flavor at Ample Hills is an impossible task; each one is so good. Fortunately they

encourage sampling.

Gotham West Market opens early and stays open late, so you can drop by for a morning coffee and pastry at Blue Bottle, grab a quick specialty hot dog and a beer for lunch at The Cannibal, meet for tapas and a drink pre- or post-theater at El Colmado, and slurp some soup and noodles late at night at Ivan Ramen. If you have a group or a family, it is the perfect spot for everyone to order whatever they want and then meet at a table to enjoy the results.

Check out Gotham West Market. It is a dining destination well worth a bit of a walk.







## JFS Will Never Forget

Commemorations were recently held in our community for the 70th Anniversary of the Liberation of Auschwitz and for Holocaust Remembrance Day. The destruction of Jewish life in Europe during the Holocaust was an unparalleled event of unimaginable proportion. Millions of lives were lost, countless families were torn apart, and those that survived were often faced with overwhelming isolation, grief, anxiety, and other physical and emotional illnesses.

Many Holocaust Survivors came to New Jersey, some right after the war ended, others during the wave of Russian resettlement in the 1990's, still others moved to the area more recently, to live near children and grandchildren. Through it all, Jewish Family Service of Somerset, Hunterdon and Warren Counties continues to recognize and respond to the unique needs of this population.

Mrs. G. recently lost her husband,

another Survivor. When her husband's health began failing last year, her children moved their parents to this area to be closer to them. Now, Mrs. G. is overwhelmed with the loss of her husband, adjusting to living alone, and trying not to be a burden to her children. This isolation and grief is bringing up painful memories of losing her parents and siblings in the Holocaust as well as anxiety regarding her own aging and a fear of being placed in an institutional setting.

Although nothing can erase the horrors of the past, JFS is able to help Mrs. G. and other Survivors receive the support they need to continue living in our community as they age. With the support of grant funding from the Conference on Material Claims Against Germany, JFS is able to provide comprehensive counseling, case management, and home health services to Mrs. G. and over 40 other Holocaust Survivors. Monthly Café Europa programs also offer Survivors an

opportunity to meet and socialize with others who truly appreciate and understand their experiences and often speak their native language.

In addition to providing the Holocaust Survivors Assistance Program, JFS is committed to serving the needs of the entire community and offers a continuum of programs and services. Licensed clinical social workers provide individual, couple and family counseling as well as geriatric assessments, supportive counseling and case management services for home bound elderly. The Family Mentor Program recruits, trains and matches volunteers with vulnerable young families or with elderly persons for friendly, supportive, in-home visits; families with children with special needs are assisted through social groups, parent groups and through the Family Mentor Program. Career Counseling helps individuals in many aspects of their job search. Ohr Tikvah-Light of Hope Jewish Healing Services offers presentations, support groups, and individual spiritual counseling to address the health, wellness and healing needs of the community. All information is confidential. Many programs are at no cost, on a sliding fee scale or payable through third party insurance.



### 6 Things to Do Before Starting a Kitchen Design Project

So you decided it's time to revamp your outdated kitchen or maybe you are planning a new kitchen from scratch. Knowing what you want and how your kitchen should be designed can be a long and exhausting process.
